

## **CHIEF EXECUTIVE'S REPORT FOR 2017**

2017 was another successful year for British Powerlifting. Membership increased by around 25% to finish at just under 4000. Each year I think that these increases in membership numbers can't continue, but they do! A significant milestone is that we appointed our first independent director Julian Harris, who will add a new dimension in our thinking.

Our application for National Governing Body (NGB) recognition was resubmitted to Sport England under their new streamlined pre-application process. Unfortunately, we have struggled to get a meaningful response and had to resort to writing in Sport England's top management. This has resulted in yet more questions, which will be answered in due course and hopefully result in a positive result. We have also had dialogue with BUCS regarding recognition for powerlifting. However, they have told us that this is contingent on us gaining NGB recognition first.

I40 national and regional tests were conducted in 2017, a significant increase over 2016. Out of these there were several adverse findings and two refusals, which have been processed by the Disciplinary Committee (DC) and the appropriate penalties imposed in accordance with the WADA Code. The cost of testing remains a major budget item, but this is money well spent to keep our sport clean. The DC has done their usual efficient job dealing with drug test failures and other matters. Regretfully, they have had to deal with other disciplinary matters concerning abusive postings on social media. This sort of behaviour is against our rules, but some members seem to think that they can say anything on-line with impunity.

Several coaching courses have been run successfully by Fred Mckenzie and Pete Sparks, aimed mostly at British Powerlifting members. They are also in the process of updating our course material, which may necessitate reapproval by PD Approval (formerly REPS). On the technical front, we continue to run many divisional referee courses around the country. However, we need more referees to commit to moving up through the ranks to get their international licences. Finding international referees able to officiate at internationals is an ongoing challenge; we are fined by the IPF/EPF if we fail to send a referee an international where we have more than four lifters.

In 2017 we ran two of our biggest ever British championships. The University Championships involved over 300 lifters and running two platforms, which was the first time we had tried this. This was very successful thanks to the assistance of Marc Giles, equipment and platform crew plus the usual intrepid team from the Farm Weightlifting Club at Moulton College. We ran the Junior championships in Motherwell with an unprecedented number of entries, which necessitated running late into the evening on all three days. However, it was a very successful event and for the first time we were very pleased to have the

inimitable Geno as the speaker, which definitely contributed to the great atmosphere.

The medals gained at internationals are shown in the appended table and there were many excellent performances. In the European Classic championship our juniors and sub-juniors did particularly well with a good haul of medal, including overall Golds. We continue to struggle on the equipped side at senior level although we do have some promising juniors and subjuniors coming through.

The Strategic Plan has been updated and a key target is achieving a 5000 membership in the next five years. As ever, we need to strengthen our administration to develop the Federation more effectively. To support this, a proposal is being tabled for an expanded Board of Directors.

A number of Executive and Non-Executive Officers do a great deal of work for the Federation and the time and commitment required is not always recognised. Our Championships Secretary Fred Sterry and Membership Registrar Carol Parker spend countless hours dealing with the ever increasing number of championship entries and members, including queries of all descriptions. Our Head of Law and Legislation Mike Patterson has also spent considerable time making sure all our documents and procedures are in order and his advice on legal matters has been invaluable. Our Finance Director continues to do a "sterling" managing our financial affairs.

We also need to recognise the terrific work done by our Head Coaches and their teams, selecting and coaching our international teams around the World.

In conclusion, I would like to thank all Executive and Non-Executive Officers for their support and hard work in 2017. In particular, the help and advice from our Chairman Fred Sterry, whose wealth of experience is a great asset to the Board.
