2026 Classic Open National Team Selection Criteria

Effective for the 2026 IPF Classic Open World Championships and the 2026 European Classic Open Powerlifting Championships

Objective

Our mission is to field the most competitive teams possible for the IPF Classic Open World Championships and the European Classic Open Powerlifting Championships.

We will continue to leverage the European Championships as a developmental platform, providing valuable international experience to lifters aspiring to compete on the world stage.

Selection Process Overview

- 1. Worlds Team Selection: Determined first.
- 2. **Euros Team Selection:** Determined second, after Worlds invitations are resolved.
- 3. **Other Events:** International or invitational teams will be selected after Worlds and Euros teams are finalized.

Team Selection Details

Worlds Team Priority and Eligibility

Lifters who qualify for Worlds will have the first right of refusal.

When the national team selects **multiple lifters in the same weight class for Worlds**, additional Euros team selections will aim to **fill other weight classes** where possible.

Selection Rationale

The **2025 British Open Championships** will serve as the primary selection meet. This ensures:

- Lifters compete head-to-head under identical conditions.
- Development of ascending lifters is prioritized.
- The prestige of Nationals is upheld, reinforcing fairness and competitive integrity.

2026 Classic Open World Championships Team Selection

Primary Selection

 The National Champion from the 2025 SBD British Open Championships in each weight class will receive the first invitation to Worlds, provided they meet or exceed the Worlds Carpino 3 Total.

Secondary Selection

- Lifters granted **dispensation** will be eligible and compared directly to the totals from the British Open.
- Any lifter (including dispensation holders) achieving a Worlds Carpino 3 Total will enter the alternate pool and be ranked regardless of weight class.
- Teams may not necessarily have a representative in every weight class; selection will focus on building the most competitive team.

 Total will enter the extended alternate pool and may be considered if primary and secondary lifters are unavailable.

2026 European Classic Open Championships Team Selection

Primary Selection

 The National Champion from the 2025 SBD British Open Championships in each weight class will receive the first invitation to Euros, provided they meet or exceed the Euros Carpino 3 Total.

Secondary Selection

• Lifters granted **dispensation** (who have not accepted a Worlds invite) and any lifter achieving a **Euros Carpino 3 Total** will enter the **alternate pool** and be ranked regardless of weight class.

Tertiary Selection

• Lifters already competing at Worlds, lifters from the 2025 British Open, and lifters from other 2025 international competitions who achieve a **Euros Carpino 5 Total** will enter the **extended alternate pool** for Euros consideration.

Tiebreaker Rules

- Same total, same weight class: Lighter body weight receives priority.
- Same total, same weight class, same body weight: British Open total receives priority if both totals were achieved at different competitions. Otherwise, it's the lifter who achieved the total first (earlier competition) receives priority.

Additional Requirements

- All selected lifters must be in good standing with British Powerlifting and not serving any period of ineligibility.
- Selection criteria may be revised for 2027 based on federation needs and international competitive standards.
