Role Overview

The Events Technology Committee supports the setup, operation, and ongoing improvement of technology used at British Powerlifting competitions. Committee members play a key role in ensuring events run smoothly from a technical perspective and provide informed guidance on how event technology, workflows, and infrastructure can be improved over time.

Key Responsibilities

- Assist with the setup, configuration, and operation of event technology at British Powerlifting competitions.
- Support competition-day systems including networking, scoring systems, displays, and other event hardware.
- Troubleshoot technical issues during events and help ensure minimal disruption to competition flow.
- Work with event organisers and officials to ensure technology is used effectively and reliably.
- Provide feedback and recommendations to British Powerlifting on how event technology and processes can be improved.
- Help document setups, processes, and best practices for future events.
- Support testing and development of new technical solutions for competitions.
- Required Knowledge & Experience
 - Basic networking knowledge, including:
 - Routers and switches
 - IP addressing and subnets
 - Experience with Raspberry Pi devices, including setup and deployment.
 - Experience using Linux, including:
 - Command-line usage
 - Basic system configuration
 - Managing services and troubleshooting
