

British Powerlifting Head Coach/Team Managers' Duties

As per the By-Laws, the duties of this role are:

- i. Be responsible for the analysis of lifters' performance and recommending selection for teams in accordance with the International Selection Procedure.
- ii. Shall recommend team coaches to the Executive.
- iii. Shall send the confirmed selections to the CEO at least one week before the closing dates for each nomination stage. These are for entering into the Goodlift system
- iv. In addition, the Team Manager/Head Coach shall complete and submit by email preliminary and final nominations as laid down by the EPF/IPF by the advertised due dates.
- v. Shall coordinate and make all necessary travel arrangements.
- vi. Shall be responsible for the proper conduct of the Team (lifters and officials), whilst travelling and at the championships.
- vii. Shall in conjunction with the coaches ensure that sensible selections are made for each lift attempt. In the event of disagreement the Manager's decision shall be final.
- viii. Shall be an IPF international referee, unless agreed otherwise by the Executive.
- ix. Following the championships shall submit a written report to the Executive.

In addition, for three lift World Championships the IPF Whereabouts Form must be completed and sent to the CEO for all senior and junior lifters.

A contribution towards travel expenses will be paid, as determined by the Executive Committee.

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
