Update on the Coaching Licence in preparations for the British Masters Championships

- We are working diligently in the background to ensure there is a smooth operation and implementation of the Coaching Licence for the British Masters Championships being held on June 28-29.
- We understand there are lots of questions being asked and we appreciate your patience.
- We are looking to expand our current guidance to answer these questions and give additional guidance on how the licence is to be implemented at National Series competitions:
 - This is so everyone knows what to expect and has consistency of expectations throughout the year.
 - There will be changes occurring as we migrate to Sport80 and we need to ensure these changes do not affect the membership in an adverse way.
 - We are working to ensure the Masters is enjoyable for everyone and if the change to Sport80 should occur before or after.
- The updated guidance should be released soon and will be in time to process for the British Masters.

What you can do until then:

- If you are on the current coaching license you have done all you can.
- If you are not, the guidance provided for this will still be accurate and implemented so please continue to get your certificates completed and uploaded.
- These certificates will be used and so having them ready to apply will be key to a smooth process in registering you for the Coaching license.
